

## TCT COVID GUIDELINES

As of Nov. 9, 2020:

- **New state mandate: Masks are required to be worn on court for doubles and group programs.**
- **Singles and Private Lessons are exempt from the mask requirement.**

- TCT will not have transactional business conducted on-site. There will be no walk-ons, all reservations must be made in advance and paid in full at the time of the reservation (or method of payment on file - no transactions will be handled on-site).
- TCT has implemented a one-way system thru the clubhouse to courts and also when exiting. Please follow accordingly.
- Masks are necessary in the clubhouse lobby, hallways and locker rooms. Masks are required to be worn on court for doubles and group programs. Singles and Private Lessons are exempt from the mask requirement.
- No more than 4 players and 1 pro per court for junior clinics.
- Players must bring their own water bottle, towel, or any other personal equipment and store them inside their tennis bag when not in use.
- Players will maintain physical distancing on and off court with personal space to place water bottle, towel, back pack, etc.
- TCT pros will enforce physical distancing 6-foot rule.
- Use headbands, hats, towels or wristbands to avoid touching their faces during play.
- Hand sanitizer and wipes will be available throughout the club.
- Ball Hoppers and all teaching equipment will be cleaned before and after each lesson.
- All players will exit the club thru exit doors on the court level that lead directly out to the parking lot to avoid passing incoming players. Pros will accompany younger juniors as they exit. Parents should wait in the parking lot for exiting juniors.

## TCT FACILITY UPDATE

TCT has taken the necessary precautions to our facility and programs to comply with the safety guidelines to ensure the safety of your junior including:

- Disinfecting nightly the entire club using an electrostatic sprayer with hospital grade disinfectant.
- Disinfecting high traffic areas (door knobs, etc.) with Clorox antibacterial wipes throughout the day.
- Installing a plexiglass divider at the front desk for staff and members safety.
- Re-positioning Lobby furniture to adhere to social distancing guidelines of 6 feet apart.
- Re-scheduling programs to reduce the number of people at the facility at one time.
- Each pro will have their own cart.
- Installing extra sanitizing stations throughout the club.
- Sanitizing the Ball machine after each use.
- Discontinuing towel service, public use of ball carts and babysitting until further notice.
- Masks will be available for staff and members.
